In preparing our high school students for PROVINCIAL EXAMS, it is good for both teachers and students to keep the following scriptures in mind:

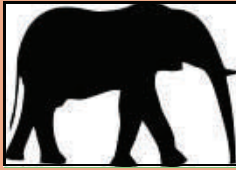
- ◇ Paul says in 2 Timothy 2:15 to "do your best to show yourself approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed..."
- ◇ Colossians 3:23-24, Paul admonishes us to work with all of our heart, strength and desire, as working for the Lord, and not (only) for men.
- ◇ Then Paul goes on to highlight the reason for his confidence— "that it is always worth the sweat and toil and time we put into the things we would sometimes rather not do. We are promised "that (we) will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward, (since) it is the Lord Christ we are serving." Wow, when you look at school, studies and exam preparation and preparing the students, from that eternal perspective, it can make a huge difference.
- ◇ Finally, the writer of Hebrews encourages us with these poignant words: "No discipline is pleasant at the time, but painful—but later on it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it".
