**HEALTHY LUNCH IDEAS**

FRESH FRUITS AND VEGETABLES make up a great part of a healthy diet but **who has time** to cut up raw veggies every day. Why can't we just buy the packaged ones? Well, of course you can however they are not fresh so they have lost some of their nutritional value and taste. They are expensive too.
